Supplies needed:

Knifty Knitter Long Loom

1 Loom Clip

Worsted weight Yarn: small amount, I do not know the brand of yarn I used in the photo above as it was in my stash and had no ball band. The yarn used in the following photos is

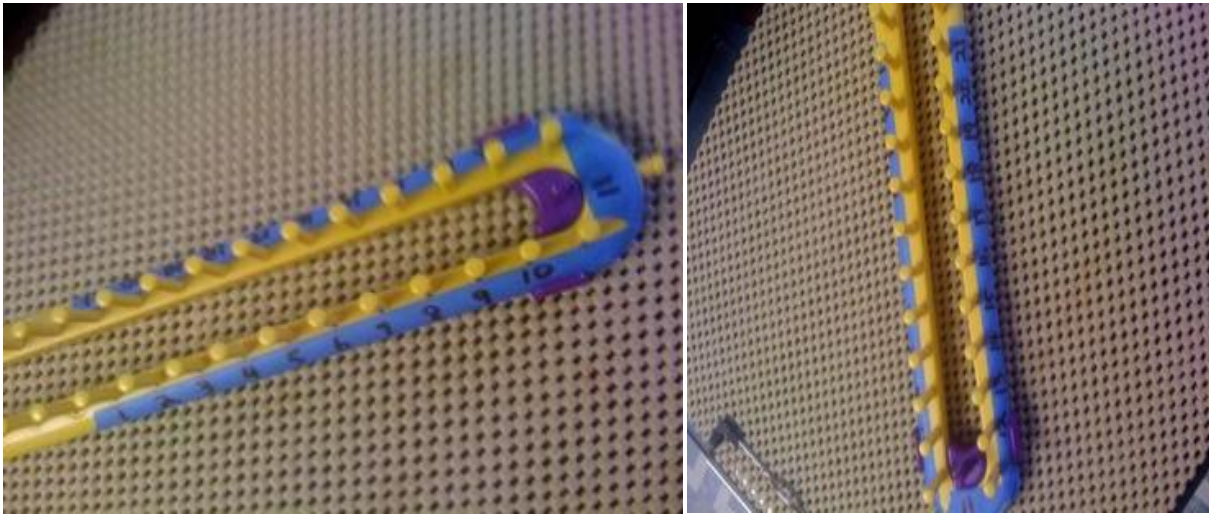
I Love this Yarn from Hobby Lobby.

Yarn needle

1 stitch holder or cable needle, I used a cable needle.

Blue painters tape or masking tape to mark loom

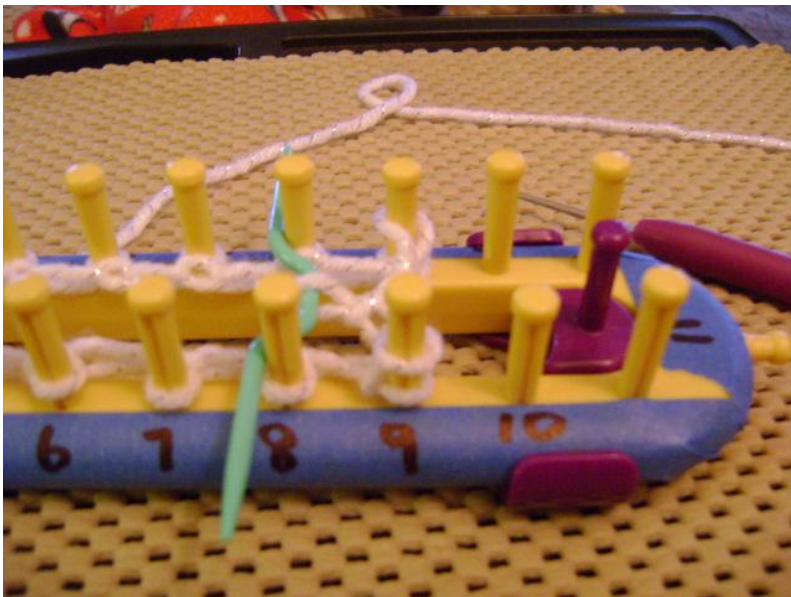
Loom Set up: Place loom clip in first set of holes at one end of the loom. Put tape on the loom on each side of the loom and the end where the loom clip is. Number the loom from 1-21, numbering from left to right around the loom.



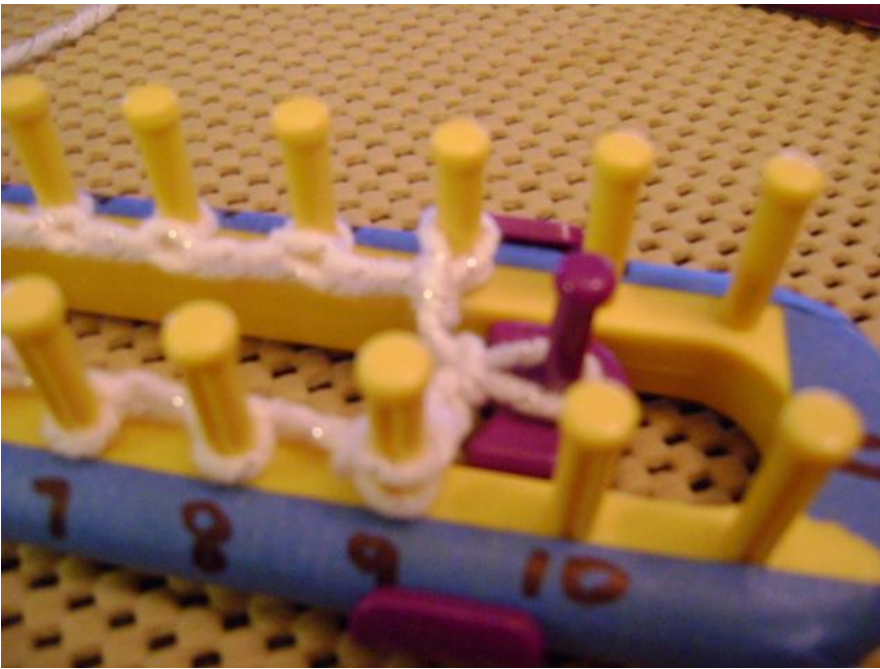
Make 2

Using the long tail cast on, cast on to 21 pegs beginning at peg 21.

Row 1 Place stitch #11 the one on the loom clip on the cable needle or stitch holder. Move stitch #10 to Peg #9 and stitch #12 to Peg #13

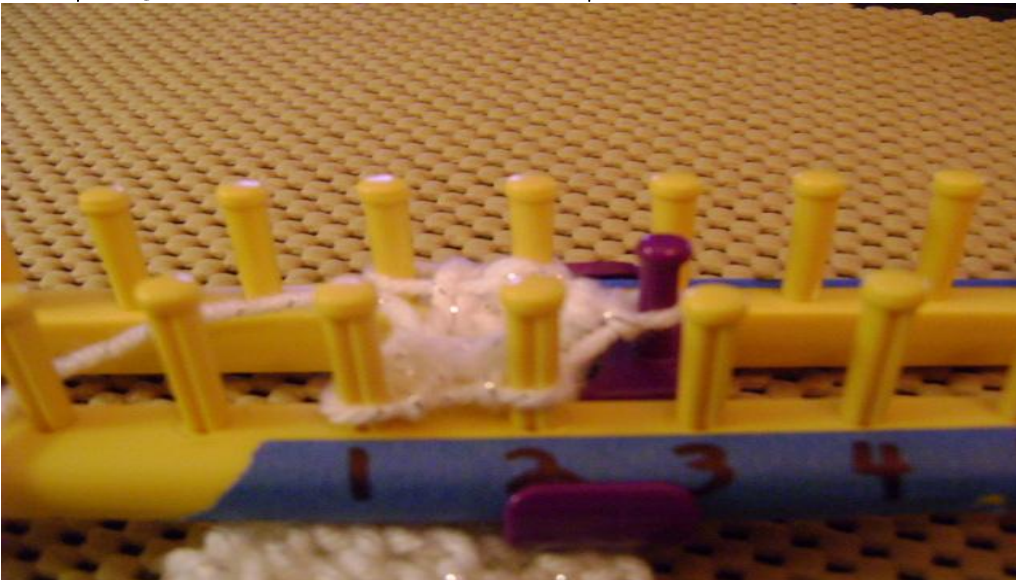


Move Loom Clip in one set of holes. Place stitch from the holder on the loom clip peg.



Slipping the first stitch e-wrap all stitches and knit off. Knit 2 over 1 on the pegs with 2 loops.

Row 2 Slipping peg 21, purl from peg 20 to 13, flat knit peg 11, the stitch on the loom clip. Purl pegs 9 to 1. Continue knitting, repeating rows 1 and 2 until there are 5 pegs left.



Bind off the last 5 pegs using the super stretchy bind off.

Now make another one just like the first.

Sew the short ends together, weave in all yarn tails.



Completed poncho.
